The Fort Smith Police Department is scheduled for an on-site assessment as part of a program to achieve its re-accreditation by verifying it meets professional standards.

Administered by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA) the accreditation program requires agencies to comply with state-of-the-art standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, administration, operations, and support services.

As part of the on-site assessment, agency employees and members of the community are invited to offer comments at a public information session to be held on Sunday, August 8, 2010 at 6:00pm. The session will be conducted in the Nan and Russell Bartlett Community Room of the Fort Smith Police Department located at 100 South 10th Street, Fort Smith, Arkansas.

Agency employees and the public are also invited to offer comments by calling 479-709-5238 on Sunday, April 8th, 2010 between the hours of 2:00pm and 4:00pm. Comments will be taken by the Assessment Team.

Telephone comments as well as appearances at the public information session are limited to 10 minutes and must address the agency's ability to comply with CALEA standards.
